Directions from Akron and Points North

Take 77 south to Exit 109 (Everhard Road, Belden Village). **Turn left.** Go to the first traffic light (Whipple Ave.) **Turn left.** Go about ¼ of a mile North on Whipple Ave. (The Automotive Technology Center will be on the right hand side of the street).

Directions from Canton and Points South

Take 77 North to Exit 109A (Belden Village Street, Whipple Ave. Everhard Road). **Turn Right on to Whipple Ave.** Go straight through one traffic light. Continue to go about ¼ of a mile North on Whipple Ave. (The Automotive Technology Center will be on the right hand side of the street).
